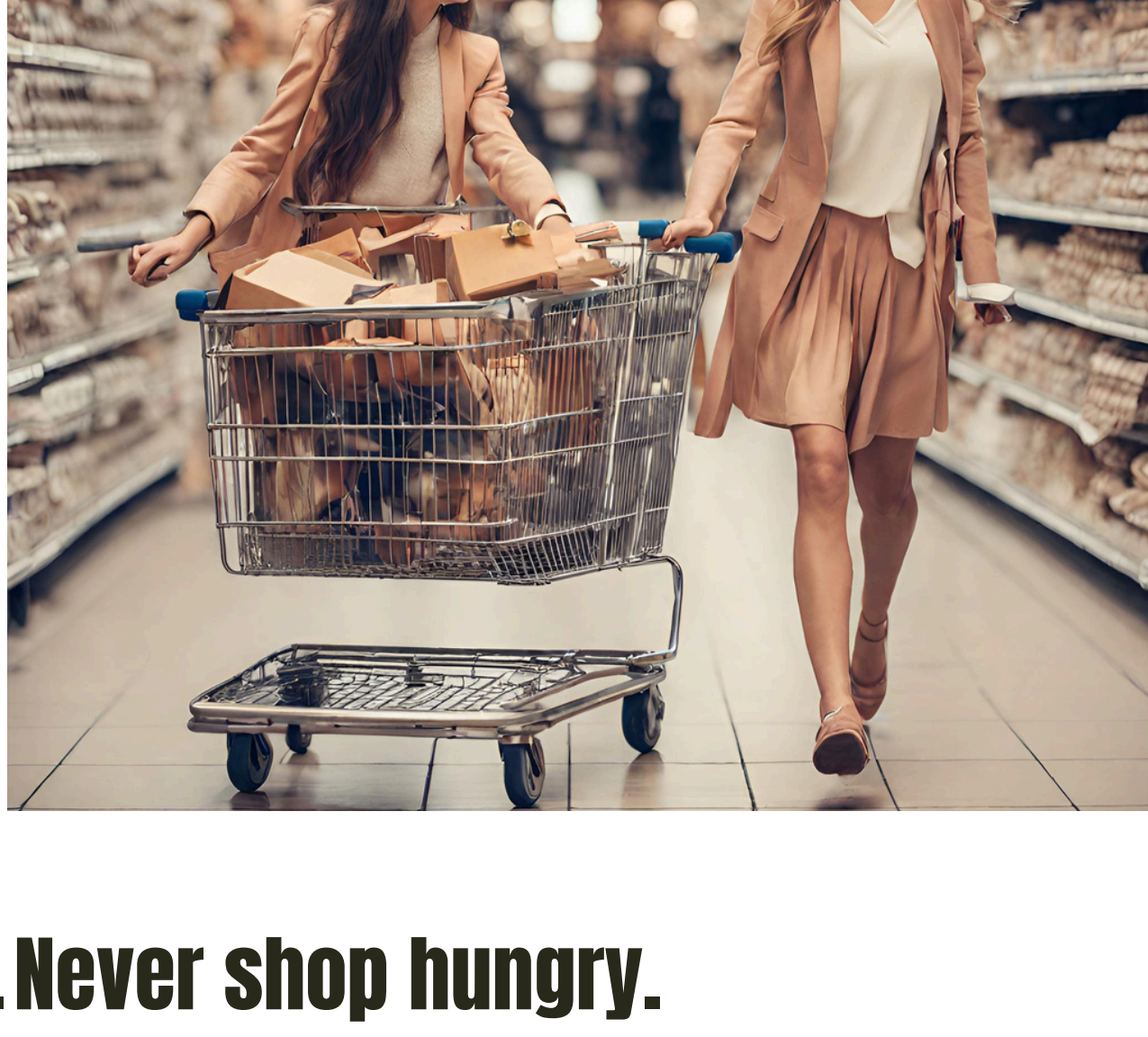


How can you save money at the store every week? We did the research- so you don't have to.

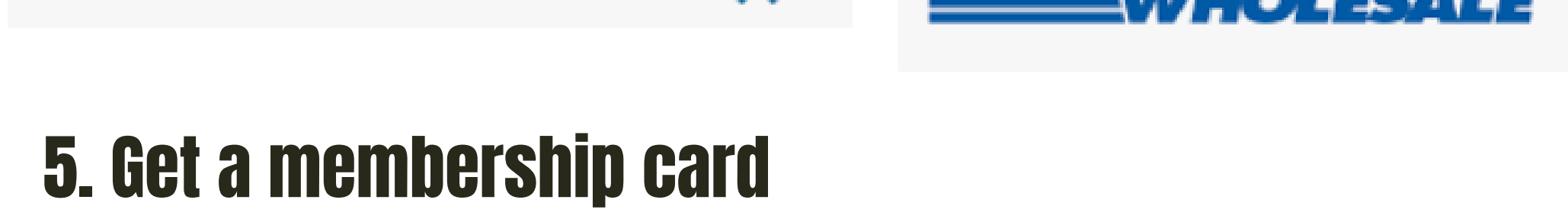
